This Month in History

- June 15, 1215 King John set his seal to <u>Magna Carta</u>, the first charter of British liberties, guaranteeing basic rights that have since become the foundation of modern democracies around the world.
- June 14, 1922 Warren G.
 Harding became the first U.S.
 President to broadcast a message over the radio. The event was the dedication of the Francis Scott Key Memorial in Baltimore.
- June 12, 1963 Civil rights leader Medgar Evers was assassinated in Jackson, Mississippi, by a rifle bullet from an ambush. He had been active in seeking integration of schools and voter registration for African Americans in the South.

 Widespread public outrage following his death led President John F. Kennedy to propose a comprehensive Civil Rights law.

Mushroom Lessons

All this rain has led to some problems in my yard and garden. I'm already seeing powdery mildew on my zucchini leaves. The weeds are about to overtake my zinnias because I can't get in there to pull them out. The grass grows faster than we can mow it. And mushrooms keep popping up in the yard.

Mushrooms are fascinating. They appear so quickly! It's like they sprout up overnight. In fact, some types of mushrooms can double in size in less than 24 hours! While the part of the mushroom that lives underground- the part we can't see- can live for a long time, the part on the surface has a life cycle of only a few days to a few weeks. The ones that are currently in my yard start out looking like little umbrellas and then, as if by magic, they quickly expand to look like pancakes.

It made me think about the verse in the Bible that says "You are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes." That verse is part of a larger warning about boasting in our confidence of tomorrow. "Now listen, you who say, 'Today or tomorrow we will go to this or that city, spend a year there, carry on business and make money.' Why, you do not even know what will happen tomorrow. What is your life? You are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes. Instead, you ought to say, 'If it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that.' As it is, you boast in your arrogant schemes. All such boasting is evil. If anyone, then, knows the good they ought to do and doesn't do it, it is sin for them." James 4:13-17

We humans are often short sighted; often we can't see past

ourselves in the here and now. We think we have all the time in the world, yet we are only a little dot on the timeline of history. God warns us to see ourselves properly in light of this. Life is fleeting. We are only a vapor...or a *mushroom*.

Psalm 90:10 says, "Teach us to number our days, that we may gain a heart of wisdom." Remembering that we are finite beings, here today and gone tomorrow, helps us gain a heart of wisdom as it helps us to properly align our priorities. We become less focused on our selfish desires and more aware of what God wants to do with our lives while we are here on earth. Obeying God and telling others about Him takes on much more urgency. That too, is a reminder for us: let God do His work in and through you. He creates amazing things! Let Him use you for the short time you are on this earth.
